

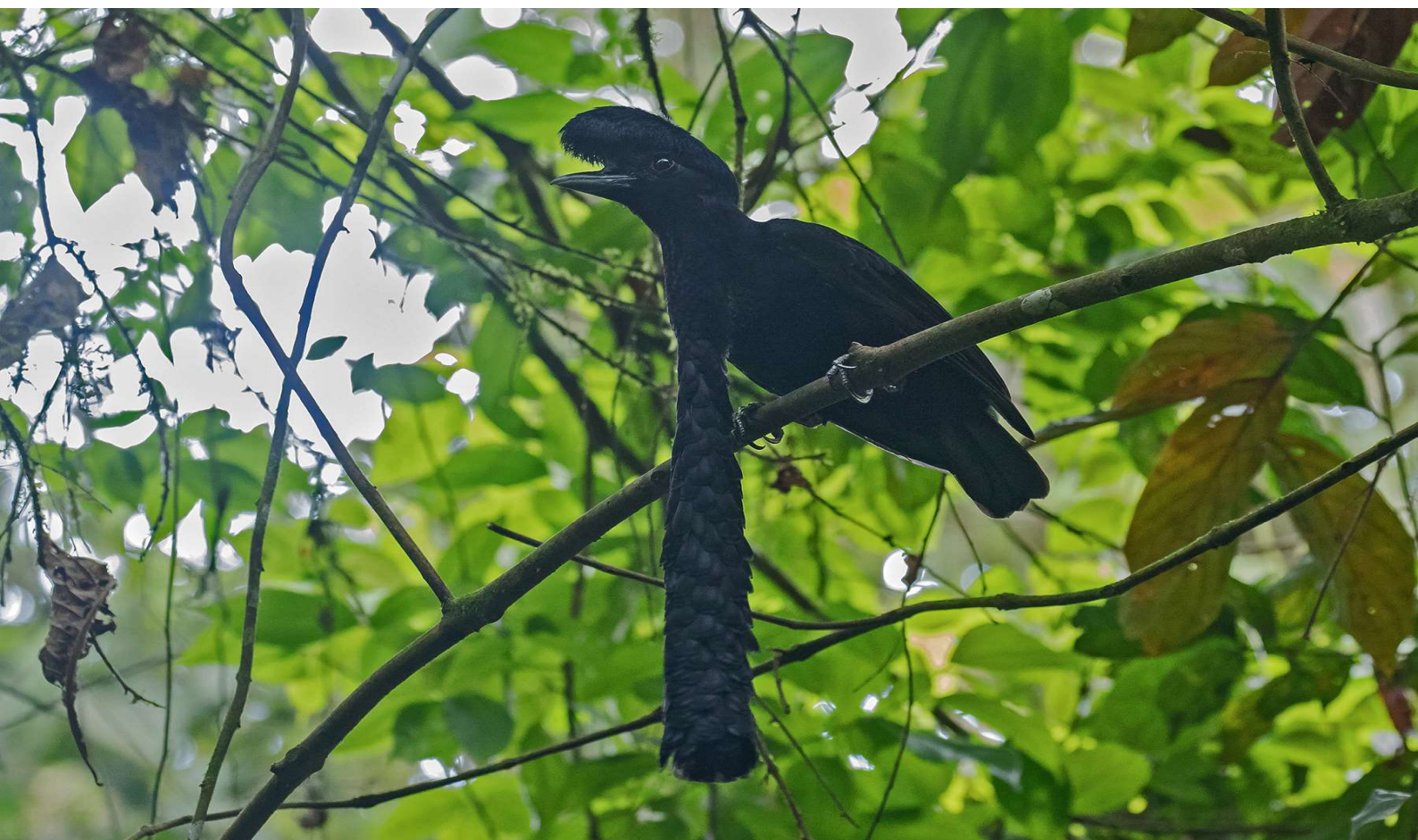

Day 1

Yanacocha Reserve (Optional), Hummingbirds Garden (Mindo Cloud Forest)

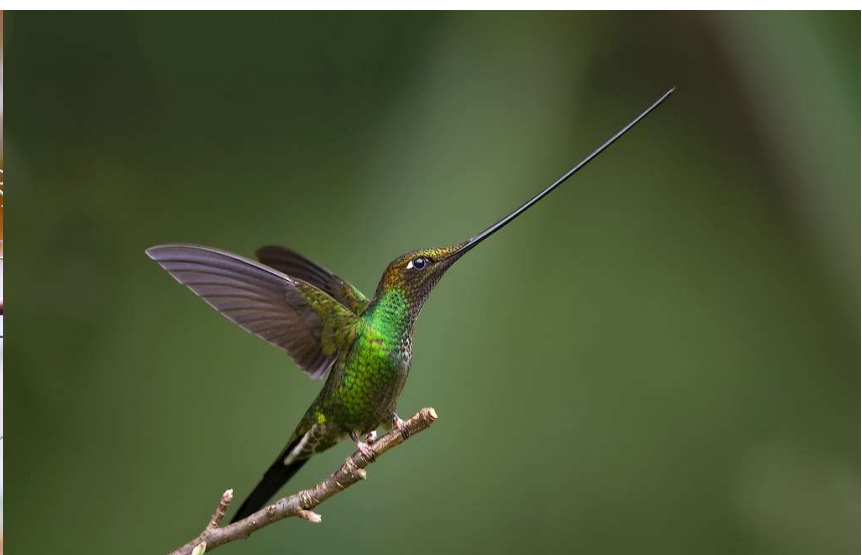
Description

We will pick you up from your Hotel in Quito or Airport area at 10:00 am. Our driver and private guide will pick you up. During the transfer to Las Terrazas de Dana Boutique Lodge & Spa in Mindo Cloud Forest, you will enjoy a snacks box which includes some natural juice, ham and cheese sandwich and a chocolate bar. On the way to our Hotel, you will have chance to stop and enjoy Los Armadillos Hummingbirds Garden in which you can have a relaxing time, drink some coffee and use restrooms if you need.

If you wish to increase your birding experience this day, for sure, you will love to visit Yanacocha Reserve (optional), therefore your schedule will change and you will be picked up from your Hotel in Quito or Airport area at 6:00 in the morning, then you will be driven for around two hours to this stunning Reserve in which you will spend an outstanding morning after you enjoy a breakfast box which includes some natural fruit, cupcakes, bananas, bread, fresh cheese, boiled eggs, coffee and milk.

Yanacocha Ecological Reserve covers an area of 964,000 hectares of forests that protect a great biodiversity of Andean flora and fauna, with an altitude ranging from 2,800 to 4,000 masl, it is home to hundreds of hummingbirds, of the 21 species that habit in the area, among them the "Black-breasted Puffleg" (*Eriocnemis nigrivestis*), declared in 2005 by the Municipality of Quito as an emblematic bird of the city for being one of the rarest hummingbirds in the world, as there are only 200 individuals left.

After lunch in their restaurant, you will be driven to Mindo through the exciting Nono old road, arrival time to Las Terrazas de Dana Boutique Lodge & Spa will be around 4:00 pm. Check in will be as detailed below.

Arrival time to Las Terrazas de Dana Boutique Lodge & Spa will be around 1:00 pm if you did not include Yanacocha Reserve in your program. At the Hotel you will have a natural welcome drink and also you will get fresh with a cool towel. After your check in, you will enjoy your Bungalow for a while, and then you will be invited to join us for your first lunch in our Restaurant. Then, all of our guests will receive a Hotel and Program Briefing; in addition, you will have a meeting with your guide this first evening of your program, in order to attend questions and concerns about your program.

After lunch and briefing, we will visit a different Hummingbirds Garden located in Mindo Town in which you will have the opportunity to check and know some dissociated species of hummingbirds than the ones you knew in Los Armadillos. At the end of this visit, you will return to the Hotel to enjoy a relaxing evening in your private terrace or our swimming pool.

Day 2 Silanche and Milpe Reserves

Description

Early in the morning, around 5:00 am you will leave the Hotel with our driver and your private guide in order to go to Silanche Reserve, the location of this Reserve is around 1 hour and 30 minutes driving. When you arrive to this destination, you will enjoy your breakfast outdoor; natural fruit, cupcakes, bananas, bread, fresh cheese, boiled eggs, coffee and milk will give you all the power that you need to enjoy this busy, but like no other day.

You will spend the whole morning in Silanche Reserve which is 300 to 350 meters (984-1148 ft) and is located after Pedro Vicente Maldonado town. It has 80 hectares (200 acres) of primary and secondary forest. This sanctuary also belongs to the Mindo Cloud Forest Foundation. There is a main trail that is in good condition, the trail is wide and they always keep it clean of dry leaves which apart from making noise when you walk. They also have an observation tower of more or less 15 meters where you can appreciate the canopy.

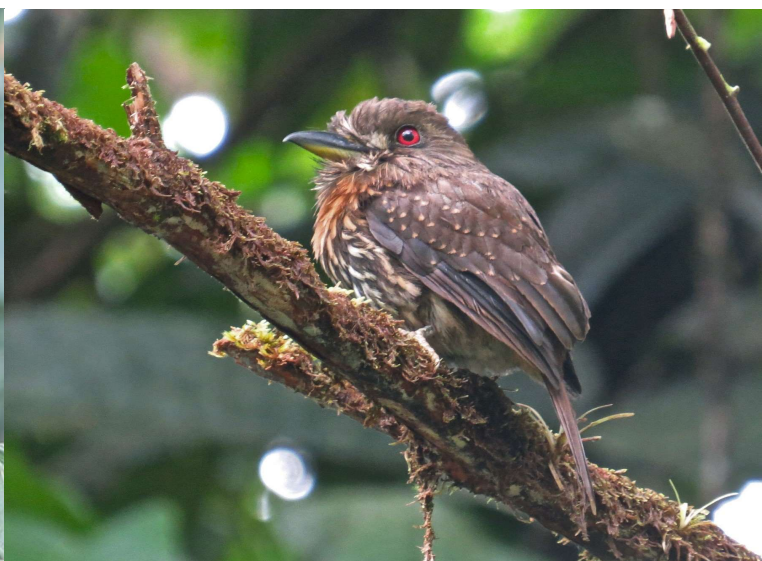
At the moment when the visit to Silanche Reserve has finished, you will be driven for around 45 minutes, you will be able to enjoy lunch time in Los Bancos Village. After lunch, we will drive for 20 more minutes to finally get to The Milpe Reserve in which you will spend the afternoon.

Mindo Cloud Forest Foundation, which is also the owner of this piece of heaven, invites birders and nature lovers to explore and enjoy the Milpe Bird Sanctuary. This is the Chocó-Andean foothills reserve, located in the Birdlife International defined Important Bird Area Los Bancos-Milpe (ECo41).

Opened in March 2004, Milpe has recently been expanded to 100 hectares (247 acres), now including the adjacent 'Milpe Gardens' which has easier access to the Chahuayacu river valley and makes a great addition to their already wide trail system. The Bird Sanctuary covers an altitudinal range from 1020-1150m (3350-3770 ft) and is located 700m off kilometer 91 of the main Calacalí-Los Bancos Highway on an all-weather road. Birding guides consider this, one of the finest sites in all of Ecuador and many of the most spectacular Chocó Endemics, occur here.

At the end of this visit, you will return to the Hotel to enjoy a relaxing evening in your private terrace or our swimming pool.

Day 3

Paz de las Aves, Alambi Reserve and Bellavista – Old Road To Mindo

Description

Departure time this day will be at 5:20 in the morning, then, by our driver and with your private guide, you will be driven for around 40 minutes in the way to Paz de las Aves location in which you will have the once-in-a life-time opportunity to sight the famed Cock of the Rock dancing and chirping for around one hour. Afterward, you will enjoy your breakfast outdoor: natural fruit, cupcakes, bananas, bread, fresh cheese, boiled eggs, coffee and milk will give you energy enough to relish this fancy place; in addition, Angel Paz and his family will let you taste a traditional breakfast on the base of mashed and fried green plantain call "bolón de verde" complemented with the best ecuadorian coffee after the program. Following the itinerary in this location, you will have chance to see and enjoy five different types of antpittas which are usually in the area.

Located 1,400 meters (4,590 ft), Paz de las Aves is a private reserve between Nanegalito and Mindo at kilometer 65-66. It has 30 hectares of primary and secondary forest. Rogrigo and Angel Paz are two brothers who have patiently trained several gralarias, who are normally very shy, to leave the tangled forest when they hear their names and then reward them with the portion of worms. The most daring is the Giant Antlaria (Giant Antpitta) called "María" who follows them everywhere in search of the worms, then Angel Paz calls "Willi" Gralaria Pechiamarillenta (Yellow-breasted Antpita) to eat. They also have training for Grausta Moustached (Moustached Antpitta) and Gralaria Pechiocracea (ocher-breasted antpitta). On rare occasions the Corcovado Dorsiosuro (dark-Backed Wood Quail) appears. The highlight bird to be sighted in this location is the Cock of the Rock, but you also have the opportunity to enjoy the company of the following birds: Giant Antpitta, Moustached Antpitta, Yellow-breasted Antpitta, Chestnut-crowned Antpitta, Ochre-breasted Antpitta.



After the visit detailed above has finished, you will be driven to the Alambi Reserve to enjoy their feeders area. The perfect climate, intact primary forest, attractive gardens by the river and handy location spanning the main highway, made it perfect and will all of their visitors have a memorable experience. You will have lunch in a local and tasty restaurant in the area.

After the visit described before, you will continue birding in the Old Road To Mindo in Upper area of Tandayapa Valley which is a beautiful slice of the Ecuadorian amazon rain forest. It is most well-known for the exceptional birding opportunities. But birds aren't the only reason to visit Tandayapa, trees literally drip with their own micro-habitats, hosting epiphytes like orchids and bromeliads. Air plants are fascinating, with their ability to grow on top of other plants, however they are not parasitic.

While there is no single best time of the year to arrive, arriving when the trees are fruiting makes it easier to see different iconic species. There is a huge network of trails throughout the Tandayapa Valley and so far explorers have discovered 330 species of bird. Scores of toucans, wrens and warblers are seen each day. Hummingbird feeders have been used to entice 31 different species to the area. Sometimes there can be as many as twenty species seen in a single day. There is certainly enough here to keep and nature lover enticed for days.

Day 4

Mashpi Road, Amagusa Reserve and San Tadeo Feeder

Very early in the morning, around 4:30 am, with our driver and your private guide, you will make a move to the well known and pristine Amagusa Reserve, after two hours ride you will eventually have chance to keep sighting some more species besides the ones you have seen the last days in this program. While you are enjoying the several spots of this Reserve, you will also have your breakfast outdoor.

The Amagusa Reserve is a privately owned 130 hectares of recovering forest in the new protected important bird area (IBA) Mashpi-Pachijal. The specific location of this forest within this IBA makes it even more special since this area is the last foothill-forest that directly connects to the lower subtropical western forest of Ecuador. Its unique location makes it particularly attractive for birders looking for the highest biodiversity regions with choco endemic birds.

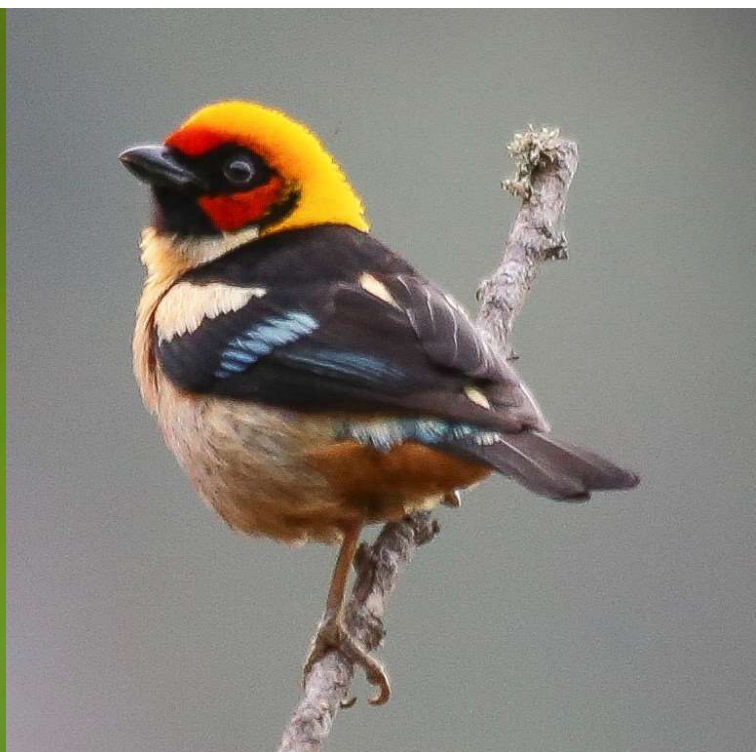
This reserve is located next to the Mashpi Road, and it is toward to the higher altitude forest. The altitude range is 1700 to 750 masl, it begins at the higher altitude pass and continues to the Mashpi Road entrance gate. The reserve extends downward to the east of the road toward a river where the forest is best conserved. There are some trails that can be visited but the Mashpi Road entrance is the best source for easy birding.



When the visit to the Amagusa Reserve has finished, all of you will have lunch in a fancy local restaurant, then, our driver will take you and your guide to this outstanding birding spot call San Tadeo Feeder which is a private spot in the top of the hill, located just 20 minutes from Mindo Cloud Forest, this spot is hummingbirds and tanagers heaven. You might catch several colorful species in only few minutes because of the altitude.

At the end of this visit, you will return to the Hotel to enjoy a relaxing evening in your private terrace or our swimming pool.

Day 5

Santa Rosa Feeder and San Lorenzo Route in Mindo Cloud Forest

Description

Just before sunrise, at 5:20 in the morning, with your guide, our driver will take you all to Santa Rosa Feeder. After 35 minutes driving, you will arrive to this birding spot which is described as excellent for photographers. Enjoy your breakfast outdoor which is complemented with some coffee provided by the location team.

There are several feeders which attract different birds, including the Plate-billed Mountain Toucan. Their moth hide is a skin that has white sheets and light that attracts insects and in the early morning there is a great variety of birds. Their hummingbirds feeder area is a good one to see new species and to take photos. There is another hideout where the toucans visit and the entire area is been set up to allow photographers to take great photos, including some "pools" to take reflection photos.



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Before noon set on, you will be back to Las Terrazas De Dana Boutique Lodge & Spa in where, before you are invited to join us for lunch, you can enjoy our swimming poll, private terrace, beautiful gardens and have some relaxing time.

After lunch and whenever you feel ready, you will be driven to the highest area in Mindo Cloud Forest, on the San Lorenzo Route. You will be able to continue with your sighting program in which, for sure, you will be able to observe various species of birds that will finally make your experience unforgettable.

You will enjoy awesome views of The Mindo Cloud Forest Ecosystem which is known worldwide for its biodiversity and birding. Mindo Cloud Forest is also characterized by the persistent low-lying clouds that deliver lots of moisture and hence thick plant growth.

Day 6 Umbrellabird Reserve (Recinto 23 de Junio)

Description

Very early in the morning our new birding day will start. At 4:00 am you will be driven with your private guide by our driver. After one and a half hour ride you will arrive to the afamed Recinto 23 de Junio which is the best sighting spot to the stunning Long-wattled Umbrellabird which could be seen flying around or in its lek. Add your breakfast outdoor to this amusing morning quest.

Recinto 23 de Junio is a small community of farmers that migrated from the south of Ecuador in search of better land more than 30 years ago. Farmers in this community are witnessing a new way of living with the arrival of bird watchers in search of the exotic Long-wattled Umbrellabird.

This bird-blessing is beginning to take effect in the community as they realize that eco-turism which provides additional incomes to the people who can find and show the wanted bird. Many of their town members are now interested in the conservation of the forest to preserve these unique species.

Lunch location will depend on the activities planned to carry on during the afternoon, whether in a fancy local Restaurant if you wish to visit some of the Reserves explored before to complement birding experience, or in Las Terrazas De Dana Boutique Lodge & Spa if you prefer to keep birding in the top area of the Valley of Mindo Cloud Forest.

Day 7 Antisana Ecological Reserve

Description

Early in the morning, around 4:00 am, you will be taken towards The Antisana Ecological Reserves by our driver in company of your private guide. We would like to suggest you to settled down any additional expenses at Las Terrazas De Dana Boutique Lodge & Spa the night before.

After 3 hours driving you will arrive to the magnificent Antisana Volcano Ecological Reserve in which you will have the opportunity to enjoy an outdoor breakfast while you feel charmed by the surroundings.

Antisana is a majestic and mysterious volcano on the western mountain range. It is the nucleus of this protected area in which we find moorlands and western Andean forests. Volcanic activity, glacial processes, and evolution have created amazing scenery along the way and a very diverse wildlife and 418 bird species.

Mirroring the volcano, we find the Mica lagoon, where part of the water of Quito comes from.

Aside from the lagoon there are also swamp areas where water collects during rainy season, forming seasonal lagoons such as Santa Lucia or Mauca Machay. There are several rivers that are born within the reserve which then slide through the western slopes and feed the rivers Coca and Napo; in the valley of Tambo there are hot springs. A few years ago it was a difficult place to access, but now it is one of the easiest places to visit from the capital and other surrounding areas.

Several stops have been planned during the visit to this stunning and huge Reserve in order you to enjoy the most and try to sight many species besides the Andean Condor which is our pointed one.

A traditional local Restaurant will be waiting for you all at lunch time, delicious food and a quite and relaxing time will be the special complement to enjoy this last part of the program.

After lunch, and when you feel ready, our driver and your private guide will drive you to your Hotel in Quito or Airport area at estimated time 4:00pm.

- During your hikes onto the trails of every Reserve, please try to walk slow and do not speak loud.
- Use natural insect repellent during your visits into the Cloud Forest and Reserves.
- Keep your eyes and skin safe from tropical sun by using hat or cap and sunglasses.
- The sun in the tropic can be intense, please pack sunblock.
- For a comfortable experience, please pack socks that will be gentle on your feet.
- Make sure your shoes are up to visit the Cloud Forest and Reserves, use comfortable hiking shoes.
- Portable flashlight will be a great help during evening.

Payment Policies

For reservations of Tours and Programs developed by Dana Expeditions in the Chocó Andino and Mindo Cloud Forest, with accommodation in Las Terrazas de Dana Boutique Lodge & Spa, a deposit of 20% of the total value of the Program is required to confirm your program.

Cancellation Policies

For cancellations of Tour or Programs developed by Dana Expeditions, a cancellation period is established without penalty up to 30 days before the arrival of the passengers. If the cancellation is made in a period established between 29 and 0 days considered to the date of arrival, the penalty will be equal to 100% of the value previously deposited to guarantee the reservation of the Program.
